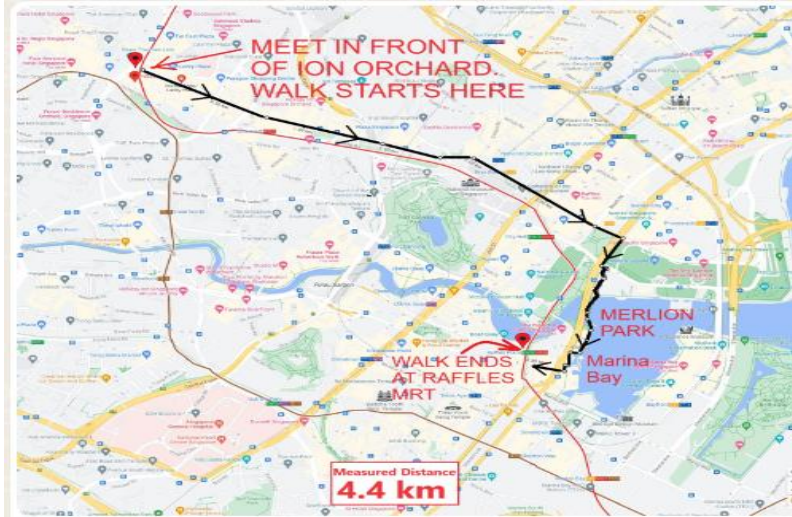




Ramble

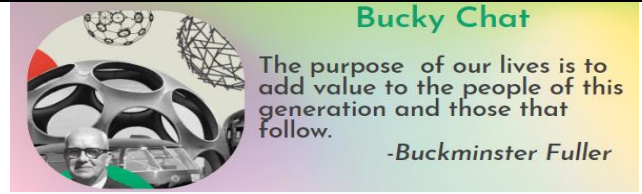

Reaching Woodlands Jetty overlooking Johor Bahru (left). This 400m jetty is the longest in Singapore.

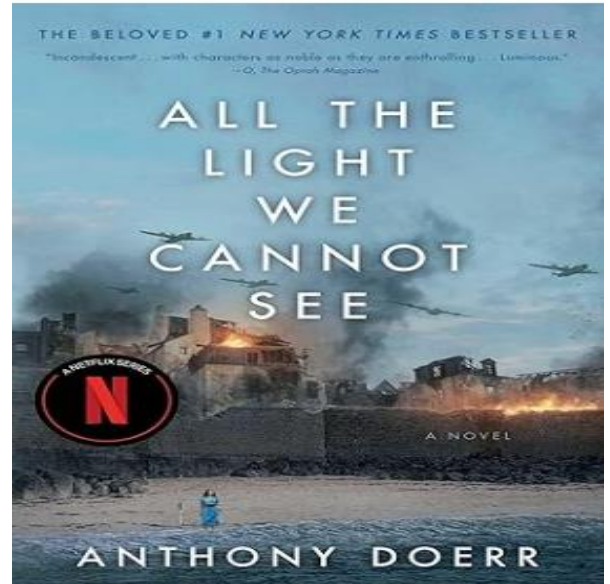


Bucky Chat
