Home to over 4,200 animals, Singapore Zoo is the world's best rainforest zoo, with its unique 'open concept' design, where animals roam in naturalistic open enclosures that mimic their rainforest environment.

#### A 700-Year Journey Through Singapore's History

From its 13th-century origins as Temasek, a thriving maritime port, Singapore became Singapura under Sang Nila Utama in the 14th century. The island later came under the influence of the Srivijaya and Majapahit empires, and subsequently the Dutch when it was part of the Johor Sultanate. In 1819, Sir Stamford Raffles of the British East India Company established a trading post, marking the start of British colonial rule.

Following the Japanese Occupation (1942–1945) and a brief merger with Malaysia, Singapore achieved independence in 1965. The exhibition vividly captures this remarkable journey from ancient port to modern global city-state.

The visit offered participants fresh insights into Singapore's rich past, revealing stories not found in school history lessons. Ms Susan brought the tour to life with vivid anecdotes—such as how early residents brought live poultry and pigs along when moving from kampongs to new HDB flats.

Ms Susan, a SACE member, recently received a 10-year Long Service Award for her work as a docent heritage volunteer. We look forward to more of her engaging and enlightening tours in the years ahead.
